Band and Choir Concerts

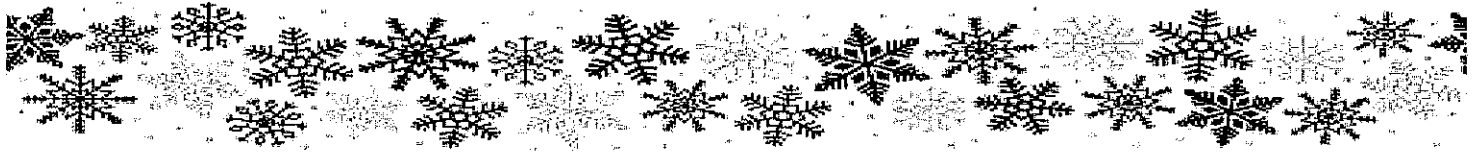
What a great turnout at our winter choir and band concerts over the last week. It was so great to see so many family members in attendance and the students really seemed to enjoy performing in front of an audience.

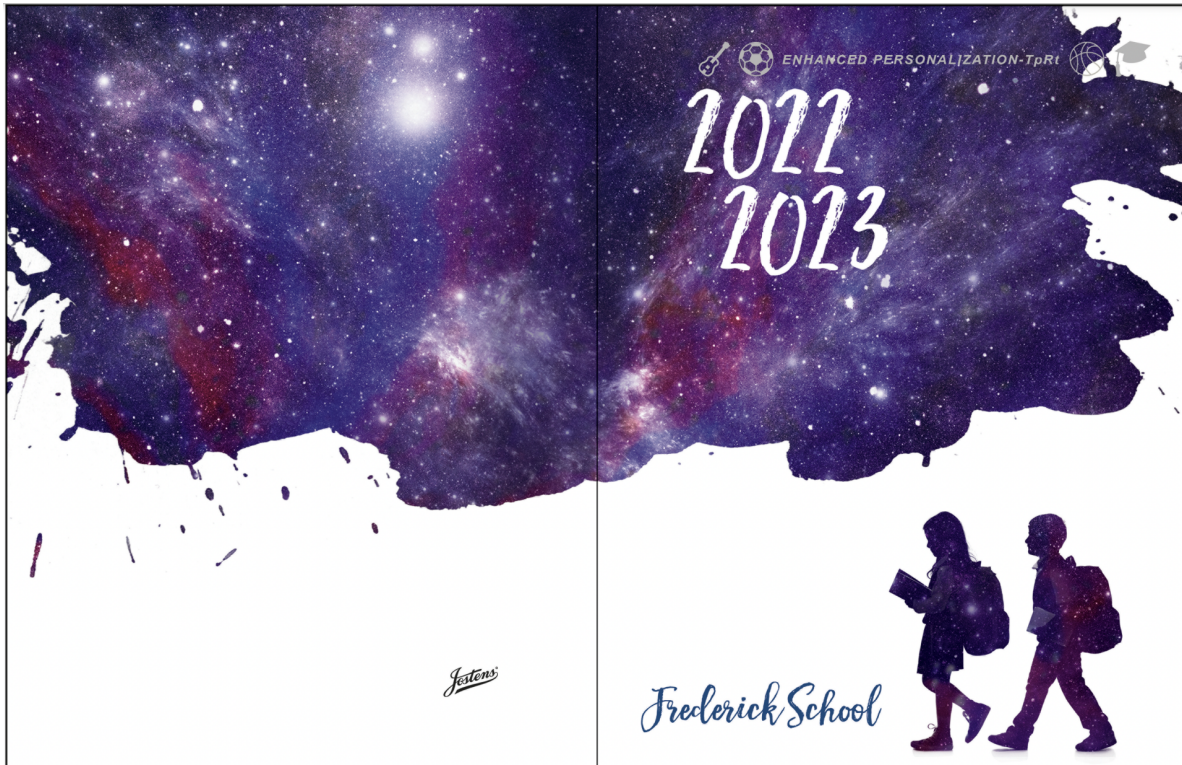

The Alliance Club is back by student request! The Alliance Club is a group that started last year at Frederick School for students who are questioning or feel they may be part of the LGBTQ+ community and their supporters (“allies”). The purpose of this group is as follows -

- To support students who are questioning or feel they may be part of the LGBTQ+ spectrum with a place where they feel comfortable and welcome.
- To give allies an opportunity to support their classmates.
- To provide a safe place where students can meet to talk about a variety of subjects in a setting facilitated by school staff. Note: the content of the discussions will be age-appropriate.
- **The purpose of the group is *not* to encourage or promote any particular ideas or to speak negatively about any perspectives/ideologies.**

The club will meet once a month with Mrs. Hennenfent and Mrs. Shipway, School Social Workers. There will be a group during the 5th grade lunch and a group during the 6th grade lunch. The club will begin after winter break. There is no cost for the club.
