Dear Parents and Guardians,

In January, students in grades K-8 participated in the Northwest Evaluation Educational Association (NWEA) Measure of Academic Progress (MAP GROWTH) or MAP for Primary Grades (MAP GROWTH K-2). CCSD 46 students in first grade take the Reading and Math MAP GROWTH K-2 test in Fall, Winter and Spring. CCSD 46 kindergarteners take the Reading and Math MAP GROWTH K-2 test in Winter and Spring. CCSD 46 students in grades 2-7 take the Reading and Math MAP GROWTH test in the Fall, Winter and Spring. Eighth grade students take the Reading and Math MAP GROWTH tests minimally in Fall and Winter. If your child took the MAP GROWTH or MAP GROWTH K-2 test earlier this year, you are being provided a copy of their results along with this information. A brochure is also being included to help in your understanding of these assessments.

We know that the MAP assessment results are important external data points regarding your child's achievement, but they may not provide a complete picture of your child. The additional data provided by your classroom teacher regarding your child's day-to-day performance at the upcoming conferences and the report cards throughout the year are significantly important. We welcome the opportunity to continue to discuss the social and academic growth your child is making. Please contact your child's teacher, the building principal or the district office if you have any additional questions.

We are writing to inform you about a student survey that will be administered at your child's school called the Illinois 5Essentials Survey. This is the eleventh year the Illinois State Board of Education will implement this survey across the state. This survey is based on 20 years of research at the University of Chicago. It asks students about their experiences in school, giving school leaders critical student input to help develop school improvement plans.

Student participants will be required to log-in using their state student ID and birth date in order to complete the survey. Students' identities will be completely confidential. Teachers or administrators will never see individual responses to survey questions and will only receive aggregated information, such as the total percentage of students who agree homework assignments help them learn the course material.

Please be aware that under the Protection of Pupil Rights Act, 20 U.S.C. Section 1232(c) (1) (A), you have the right to review a copy of the questions asked of your student(s). Si su hijo(a) tomó la prueba MAP GROWTH o MAP GROWTH K-2 a principios de este año, se le está proporcionando una copia de sus resultados junto con esta información. Un folleto también está siendo incluido para ayudar en su comprensión de estas evaluaciones.

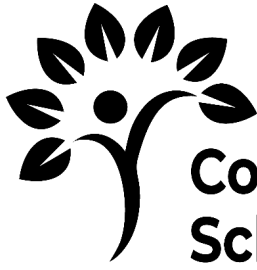

Parents, teachers and students in Grades 4-8 in Community Consolidated School District 46 will have an opportunity to participate in the annual statewide Illinois 5Essentials Survey. This survey, available in English or Spanish, is designed to generate a detailed picture of the inner workings of your child's school. As a parent, this opportunity will allow you to share your thoughts on the important elements of school effectiveness in a survey about your child's school. On behalf of the Illinois State Board of Education, the Illinois 5Essentials Survey will be administered online by UChicago Impact at the University of Chicago. The survey gathers data related to five indicators that can predict important student outcomes, including improved attendance and larger test score gains. These five indicators that affect and predict school success are:

- Effective Leaders
- Collaborative Teachers
- Involved Families
- Supportive Environments
- Ambitious Instruction

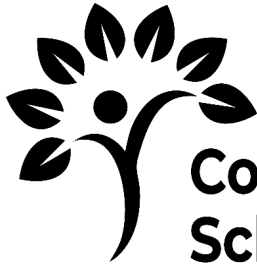
Prior research in more than 400 schools has shown that schools that were strong on at least three of these "5Essential" indicators were 10 times more likely to improve student learning gains in math and reading than those that were weak on three or more Essentials.

If at least 20 percent of parents complete this survey for a school, a parent supplement will be generated. The parent data will be used by the district as a measure of continuous improvement. Teachers across the district and students in grades 4-8 will be responding to this survey. Your participation in the parent portion of the survey will help us understand the conditions at your child's school and guide improvement. Your identity and survey responses will be kept completely confidential and will never be connected to you or your child. For parents, the Illinois 5Essentials Survey will be available through March 31, 2023. To take the survey please visit <https://survey.5-essentials.org/illinois/> and select the appropriate survey to begin.

For students in Grades 4-8, the Illinois 5Essentials Survey will be administered during school. This survey should take approximately 25 minutes to complete. Please see the additional information regarding the Student Survey for more details.

- Ambitious Instruction (Enseñanza Exigente)

Investigaciones previas realizadas en más de 400 escuelas, han demostrado que escuelas que obtuvieron resultados fuertes en al menos tres de estos indicadores '5Essential' tienen una probabilidad 10 veces más grande de mejorar la capacidad de aprendizaje de los alumnos en las áreas de matemática y lectura.

Si por lo menos el 20 por ciento de los padres de una escuela completan esta encuesta, se generará un reporte suplementario con esta información. Los datos de la encuesta de padres serán utilizados por el distrito escolar como medida para continuar mejorando el desempeño de la escuela. Maestros del distrito y alumnos de 4^{to}-8^{vo} grados participarán en esta encuesta.
