Dear Frederick Families

We hope that everyone has had a great week and is looking forward to the long weekend. Remember that there is no school on Monday as we are closed in observance of Indigenous People's Day.

Tuesday will be a special day as we are launching our new composting and expanded recycling program here at Frederick. Thank you to all the parents who have volunteered as we get going! We are excited to see the impact that we can have in reducing our waste and contribute to a healthier environment.

To this point in October, we have been pretty lucky with the really pleasant weather, but we are definitely starting to see signs that fall is coming and it will soon be much cooler outside. Please remember that we aim to have students outside daily for recess, so students dress comfortably for the weather. While the next week's forecast looks pleasant overall, the cooler temperatures are on the horizon and we want all students to feel comfortable.

We also wanted to let everyone know that in recent weeks, we have seen an increase in the number of damaged chromebooks. The majority of the frequent issues have included cracked or broken screens and removed keys, but we have also had a few instances of cases being removed.

The chromebook is a valuable tool for your student's school day, and students should remember that it is necessary to bring to school fully charged each day. We also want to avoid costly repairs that parents may be responsible for to the fullest extent possible. While we have established routine chromebook expectations with our students, we do have a few helpful reminders to help reduce the chances for damage to the devices:

- 1. Do not remove the chromebook case. It must remain on the device at all times.
- 2. Do not walk or move with the chromebook while it is open.
- 3. Please do not pry or attempt to remove keys from the chromebook. The plastic can break and it will need replacement.
- 4. Avoid eating or drinking while working on the chromebook. Liquids can be especially damaging to electronics!
- 5. If your child notices any issues with their device, please have them report it at school as soon as possible. Please do not attempt any repairs yourself.
- 6. When at home, make sure the chromebook is kept in safe and secure location.

Please remember that we also asking all families to submit confirmation that they have reviewed the student handbook for the 24-25 school year. If you have not done this yet, there is information on how to do so later in this newsletter.

Halloween - Thursday, October 31st

Halloween is coming! Frederick students are allowed to wear costumes, but we do not have specific Halloween celebrations or class parties like those that have occurred in the elementary buildings.



Costumes should be comfortable and conducive to learning. When helping your child choose a costume, please remember that weapons and other suggestions of overt violence (i.e. blood and/or gore) are **NOT** allowed. It is also important to take into consideration that some families are deeply offended by the representation of witches, ghosts, vampires, devils, werewolves, and goblins. Please be courteous when assisting your child in choosing a costume.

Costumes must also abide by the "Student Dress" expectations described in the student handbook. School staff also reserves the right to remove disruptive costumes or portions thereof. Please keep in mind that some costumes (i.e. inflatables or large costumes) may not be suitable for school due to space and movement limitations (i.e., sitting at desks and tables, bus seats, participating in P.E.)

Halloween is taking place during our annual Red Ribbon Spirit Week, so we are looking forward to a week filled with different fun themes. Thank you very much for all your support and understanding!

Student Council Rec Nights - Coming Soon!!!

Rec Nights are a popular drop-off event for our students that includes an evening of fun at school with a DJ and an open gym - all provided with \$5.00 admission! There are also concessions, raffle tickets for prizes, and a few extra games available for additional purchase. The dates for the first Rec Nights are as follows:

Friday, October 25:6th Grade Rec Night - 6:30 - 8:30pmFriday, November 1st:5th Grade Rec Night - 6:30 - 8:30pm

Please note that these events are open **ONLY** to Frederick students in the designated grade level. These events have always been very popular as our students are given the opportunity to connect with each other for an evening of fun in a supervised environment.

Cell phones will **NOT** be allowed at Rec Nights. All students are encouraged to leave their cell phones at home. If a student does bring his/her phone to the event, they will be required to check their phone for safekeeping and it will be returned at the end of the night. If for some reason they need to contact a parent during the event, they can use the school phones or they can use their cell phone with supervision from an adult. We started this practice a few years ago and found it really encouraged students to have a fun evening free from devices and eliminated many issues related to social media.

Rec Night Frequently Asked Questions:

Q: Who supervises this event?

A: Supervision will be provided by Frederick staff and other volunteers including parents of student council members. All areas that are accessible to students will be supervised. Students MUST follow all school expectations, and if this is an issue a student may be required to leave the event early.

Q: How much money does a student need?

A: All students will need to pay the admission cost, which is \$5.00. We would appreciate it if students could bring a five dollar bill or singles instead of larger bills that can be difficult to make change. Additional items will be available for purchase which include raffle tickets, concessions (pizza, nachos, candy, drinks), and extra games for prizes that range (like ring toss) from an additional \$1.00 - \$2.00. Typically, we have seen most students will spend an additional \$5 - \$15 dollars on these items or activities.

Q: Help! My child thinks they need to "ask" someone to go with them?

A: In the past, some students have been under the impression that they need to ask someone, like a date. This is **NOT** the case! In fact, we discourage this practice and just want our students to be able to have some fun with their classmates!

Q: How does pick-up work?

A: Rec Night will end at 8:30pm. We ask that all students are picked up promptly. Because we anticipate large crowds, please use both the main parking lot and small circle drive. It will be helpful for you to talk about pickup arrangements ahead of time as it will be pretty dark, and your child can expect where to find their ride.

Carpooling when possible will also be a great way to help traffic flow much more smoothly!

Upcoming Vision and Hearing Screenings

The Lake County Health Department will be onsite to perform vision and hearing screenings. At the 5th and 6th grade levels, students who receive special services (IEP or 504) and students new to our district will be automatically screened. Screenings are scheduled for next Thursday, October 17th




2024 -2025 Yearbooks On Sale NOW!

Participants should wear shorts, t-shirts and/or sweats and have clean gym shoes. No bus after the sessions!


