Dear Frederick Families,

We hope that everyone has had a great week! In this week's message, I have a few different topics that I wanted to address with everyone. First, please remember that there will be no school on Monday, January 20th as we will be closed in observance of Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Day. As we take the day to honor the legacy of Dr. King and his fight for equality and justice, we encourage everyone to keep his message alive by doing his or her part to contribute to a just and positive community in which all are treated equally and with respect.

Also, this past week we had a cold snap that lasted several days and impacted our ability to hold outdoor recess. While the temperatures had increased yesterday and today, we are expected to face some bitter cold again when school resumes on Tuesday. We do not plan to have students outside in extreme cold, but it is important that students come to school dressed warmly for the conditions as there will be time outside as they enter or exit the building or wait at their bus stops or the pickup line.

Next, In past newsletters and communication, we shared that our goal is to help all students **SOAR** (be Safe, take Ownership, and Always be Respectful). We believe these key actions help contribute to a positive and safe school community for everyone. As we strive to help students develop ownership over their learning and responsibilities, we have seen an increase in the number of chromebooks being left at home or coming to school uncharged. Chromebooks are a vital tool for students to be able to access class materials and assignments. To help promote ownership, it would be beneficial to work with your child to identify typical routines for management of chromebooks and other school materials at home to ensure that they are kept in safe location to charge so they are ready for the next day.

We are proud of the efforts of our Falcons as they continue to grow and learn, becoming more responsible and independent along the way! Ownership is a key concept to what we strive for at Frederick, and helping students make sure they are prepared and ready with their necessary materials each day is very helpful.

The third session of intramural is starting the week of February 3rd! Please review the link to the registration form and club descriptions below:



Reminder: Outdoor Recess During Winter

We strive to offer outdoor recess daily and will always consider the current weather and area conditions. When temperatures are below 40 degrees, we provide students an option between outdoor and indoor recess activities. If the temperature drops to where the "real feel" is below 10 degrees, all recess activities will be indoors only.

When fields are covered in snow, students will only be able to play in snow covered fields if they are wearing appropriate winter gear (at minimum this must include a coat, snow pants, and boots.) While we want our students to be able to enjoy the snow, we also want to make sure that they are comfortable and dry upon returning to class.

In addition to temperatures, we also consider the conditions of our blacktop areas or fields. For example, indoor recess may also be called if our blacktop areas are too slippery or if the fields are flooded or muddy. The safety of all students will always be our number one priority when making these decisions!

We ask for your support in making sure that your child is dressed appropriately for the weather conditions each and every day.
